Light refreshments will be served.



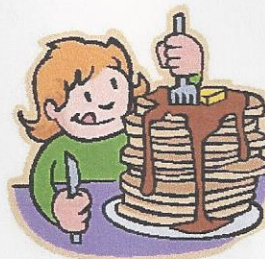
FIREWORKS FOR FEB FEST

GET READY TO DIAL EXTRA NUMBERS

The new area code overlay approved for the west-central portion of New York will be effective starting **February 11, 2017**. The new 680 area code will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 315 area code. This overlay does not require customers to change their existing area code, but **new** customers may be given the 680 area code. Starting March 11, 2017, this means your new neighbor just down the road from you may have a 680 area code in their telephone number.

Starting on February 11 all calls in the affected area must be dialed with ten digits – the area code (either 315 or 680) and the seven-digit telephone number. All calls placed outside the 315 or 680 area will require you to dial 1 + area code + number. If you do not use the new dialing code after February 11, your calls will not be completed.

IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER: Not only will you have to dial extra numbers, but be sure to update and remember to include your area code when listing your phone number on important forms in the future.
