

**RESOLUTION TO COMPLETE AND CODIFY THE TRANSITION BACK TO BOOKKEEPING AT THE TOWN LEVEL NOW THAT THE LOCAL ACCOUNTING SOFTWARE IS OPERATIONAL – TERMINATION OF THE COUNTY AGREEMENT**

Whereas, the Town of Morehouse was audited by the Comptroller's Office and it was determined that changes were needed, and

Whereas, the Town Board and the Town Supervisor have been implementing said changes, but more capacity in the Town Office is necessary for the Supervisor, and

Whereas, a comparison of the annual cost for Account Software versus the cost for the contract with Hamilton County indicates that a change would allow funding for someone to be present more hours in the Town Office, and

Whereas, the Town Board would like a greater presence in the Town Office, plus feels that this change will also assure the Town doesn't fall behind in the future through creating continuity as well as added capacity, and

Whereas, the County has indicated a willingness to terminate the current agreement on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and

Whereas, the changes at the Town level now include operational Town Accounting software, as well as the Supervisor and the Town Board working together to add staff capacity. Now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Morehouse Town Board formally authorizes the termination of the Bookkeeping contract with Hamilton County effective June 30<sup>th</sup> 2022, and be it also

Resolved, that the Morehouse Town Board expresses their sincere thanks to the County Treasurer and her staff for the services they have provided, and be it further

Resolved, that a certified copy of this Resolution be forward to the Hamilton County Treasurer.


