**Made in America**

Unfortunately many of the products or food we use or consume today are manufactured or originate from China and other countries. It is important to carefully read product labels. Some labels are deceiving by boldly displaying an American flag or listing "American" in part of their name, while in small print showing "Made in (another country)".

According to the website Snopes.com, it is also not helpful to try and read the first three digits of bar codes to determine the product's origin. "For example, a company may have its headquarters in South Africa. The EAN organization in South Africa has the code "600", but all products of the company may be manufactured in England. The English-made products would still have the "600" prefix

code.....In determining the country of origin, the consumer still must rely on the standard method of looking for "Made in (country)" labels on the packaging."

Check your computer for listings of companies that still provide products "Made in America".
